Judy Gilreath, Superintendent, recommended that the board approve the Facilities Use Agreements as presented. Louis Fordham moved approval and Rodney Lock seconded. The board approved 5-0.

Approval of School Bus Purchase

Mike Ewton, Chief Officer of Operations, told the board that because of the performance of the Thomas Built Buses that were purchased last year, I would like to recommend that we purchase three additional Thomas Built 72-Passenger School Buses. This would be purchased with our bond money that has been allotted to our system for fleet improvement. Mike told the board that we would be purchasing these buses off of the Georgia State Contract with the additional Whitfield County specific specifications. The price of these buses would be \$86,970.00 per bus, giving us a grand total of \$260,910.00 for the total purchase amount. He said that our allotment of bond money from GaDOE thia year is \$231,660.00 so this would only require the expenditure of \$29,250.00 of our actual Whitfield County Funds that we have allocated for bus purchases. Mike said that these buses would be put into service for the 2014-2015 school year. Mike thanked the board. Dr. Gilreath recommended the board members approve the request to purchase the three buses. Thomas Barton moved approval and Bill Worley seconded. The board approved 5-0.

Support Services

Approval of Purchase of Vehicle for School Nutrition Department

Wanda Phillips, Chief Officer of Support Services, introduced Angie Brown, Director of School Nutrition. Angie told the board that the School Nutrition Department would like to propose the purchase of a vehicle for department use. She told the board that the vehicle would be used for multiple purposes as specified below:

- Travel for School Nutrition Department IT Specialist. The technician currently services all 22 schools manager computers, point of sale computers and scanning/pin pad devices
- Travel for required out of town travel for mandated training
- Travel for required site reviews for Lunch Program, Afterschool Snack program, and Summer Feeding Program at all 22 schools conducted throughout the year
- Transport food in emergency situations (i.e. power outage, water outage, kitchen equipment failure)
- Utilized in Summer Feeding Program as a mobile unit

The proposed vehicle is a 2014 Ford Escape, S Model. Angie told the board that Rick Holsomback, Director of Transportation, has obtained Government Contract information from Brooker Ford. The government price is \$19,968.00. Angie thanked the board for their consideration. Dr. Judy Gilreath recommended the board approve the purchase of the vehicle for the School Nutrition Department. Rodney Lock moved approval and Bill Worley seconded. The board approved 5-0.

Approval of Drain Cleaning Services

Angie Brown, Director of School Nutrition, said that the School Nutrition Department requests the Board of Education approval of A-1 Pumping, Inc. as approved vendor for drain cleaning services. They will also be the vendor of choice for the Whitfield County Maintenance Department. Two vendors responded to request for pricing. A-1 Pumping, Inc. met all bid terms and conditions and they were the lowest bidder. Dr. Judy Gilreath recommended the board approve A-1 Pumping, Inc for drain cleaning services. Tony Stanley moved approval and Bill Worley seconded. The board approved 5-0.

- Baseball field new backstop netting and padding, new dugout padding and netting, infield renovation, and new windscreens on outfield fence and foul line with lettering
- Gym painting

Dr. Gilreath recommended the board accept the check in the amount of \$75,000.00. Bill Worley moved approval and Louis Fordham seconded. The board approved 5-0.

Donation Check for Dug Gap Elementary School

Dr. Gilreath said that Dug Gap Elementary School was given a donation check in the amount of 36,000.00. As construction began on the parking lot at Dug Gap Elementary, issues began to surface that were overlooked in the original estimate. The retention pond needs to be enclosed with a fence as a safety precaution. Also, in an effort to make this transition as smooth as possible for our adjoining neighborhood, we agreed to add some landscaping at the edge of our property. Dr. Gilreath recommended the board accept the check in the amount of \$36,000.00. Bill Worley moved approval and Tony Stanley seconded. The board approved 5-0.
